

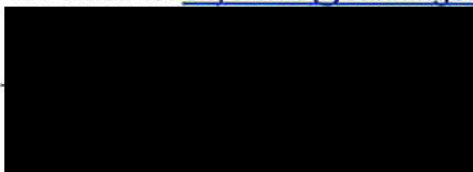

**1. Tell us about your background, including education, work, and volunteer experience, civic involvement, and other experience relevant to this appointment.**

I have a B.A. in Music and an M.A. in Education. I hold teaching credentials in Special Education, Music, and English. I taught for Banning from 1997 to 2019. I spent most of teaching career working with students who had learning disabilities. I also had the opportunity to do extracurricular work as a choir director and performing arts club director. I supervised student fund raisers, performances, and field trips. I was able to take a group of about 40 students to Disneyland workshops for seven years in a row. My show choir performed at StageCoach Days. I also collaborated with the high school drama teacher to produce the musicals "Once on this Island," "Fame," and "Just Another High School Musical. I co-founded/started Cherry Valley Horsemen's Association and I was Youth Director for Palm Springs Arabian Horse Club.



**2. What unique skills and traits would you bring to the commission?**

I raised my two boys in Banning. We frequented all of the parks over the course of their youth. They were involved in sports, gymnastics, field trips to Dodger Stadium, swimming, and the Day Camp program. Now, my grandchildren frequent Lyons Park and the pool. I myself attend water aerobics and water Zumba classes. I think I would bring a lifetime of experience in the diverse needs and desires of families, children, and seniors in the community.

**3. Identify specific problems or issues facing the Parks and Recreation Department and how you feel they might be resolved.**

I lived on the east side of Banning when my kids were small. We went to Roosevelt Park, but it was called Eastside Park back then. You knew you had to be out of there by about 4:00 pm, because cars would line up on George Street to party, and to use and sell drugs. There were streetwalkers there as well. They got that area cleaned up sometime after we moved. Recently, I've noticed a similar problem at Replier Park. Homeless tend to gather there under the shelter not far from the playground. It's a complicated issue. Most of them are harmless, but there is still the potential for alcohol and drug use and the question of whether it's a totally safe environment for kids.

**4. Why are you interested in serving on the Parks & Recreation Commission? What do you hope to achieve during your term of service?**

Now that I'm retired, I'm looking for ways to get involved and give back to my community. I've seen a lot of good programs come and go. I would like see more opportunities for community involvement; more classes, some field trips, more performing arts activities; plays, a community choir perhaps, a Zombie walk and haunted house on Halloween, a community choir singing at the Christmas Tree lighting ceremony. I could go on, but those are a few of my ideas.
