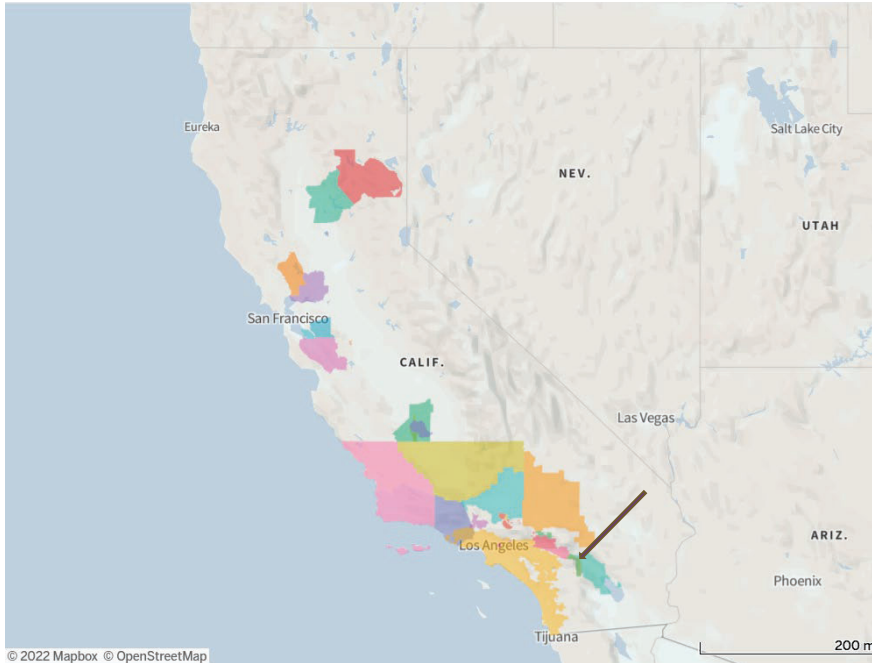

Bring supplemental water to the region to meet short and long-term needs.

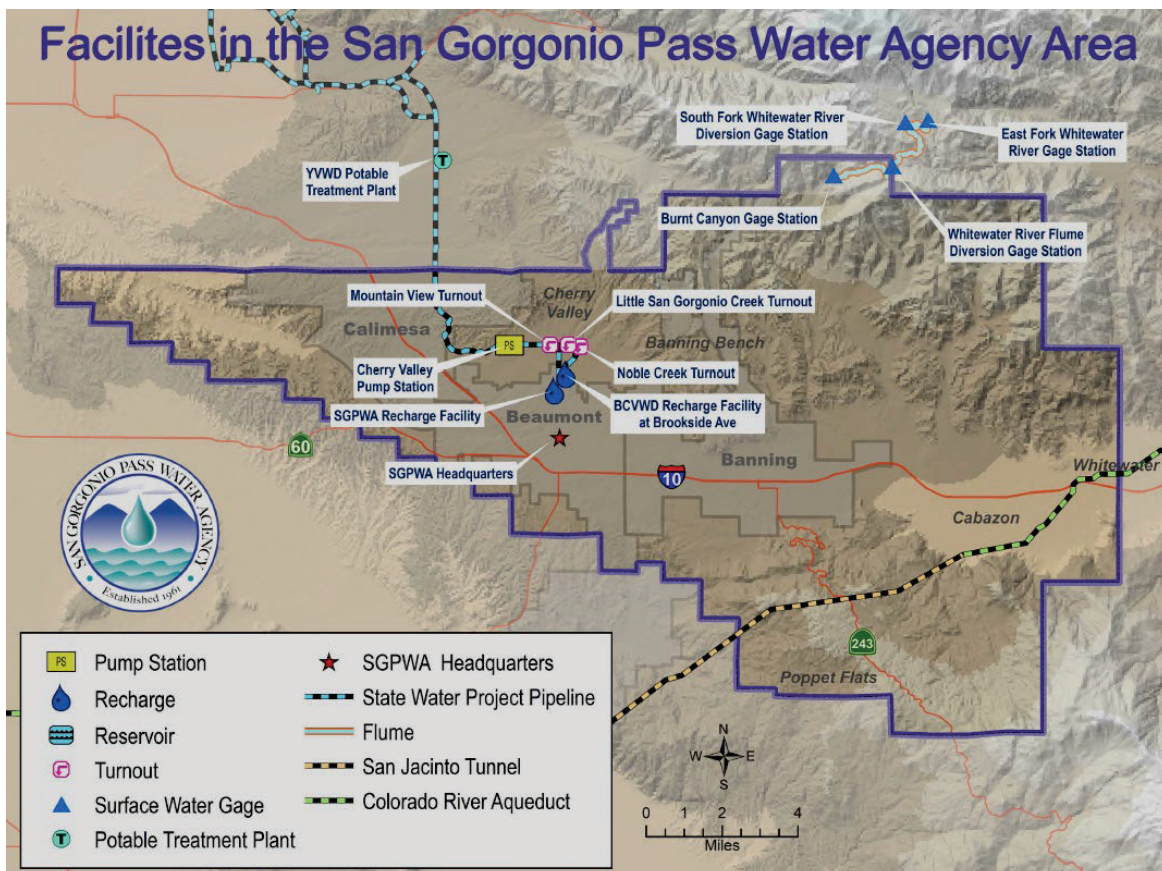

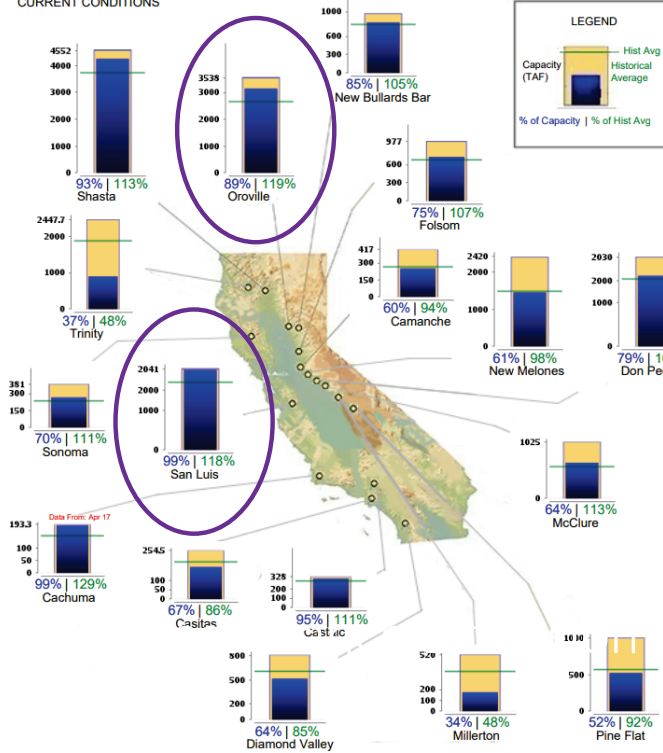
The State Water Project moves water from Northern California to Southern California

- 29 State Water Contractors
- Capable of moving over 4 million acre-feet per year
- Uses the snowpack from the Sierra's as a "reservoir"
- Provides water for over 23 million people
- Sustains 5th largest world economy

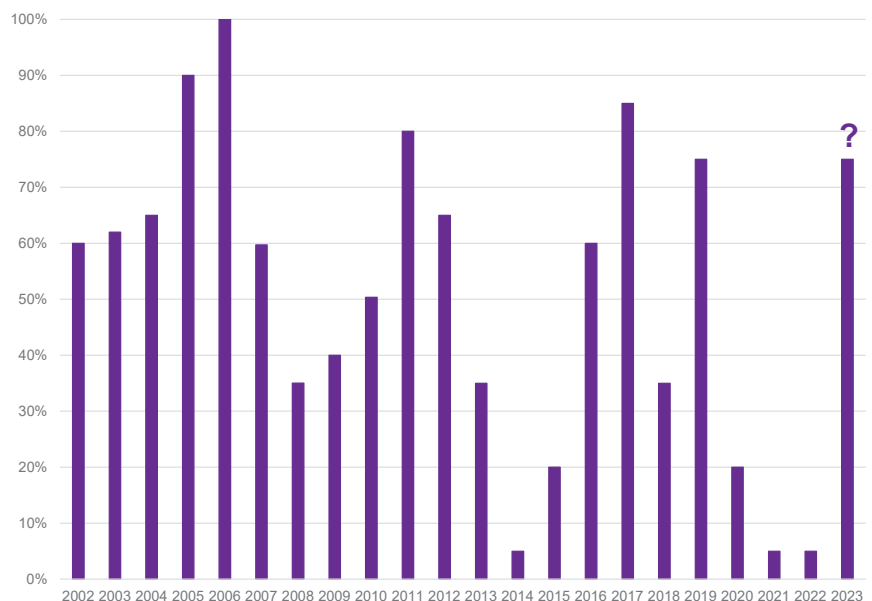

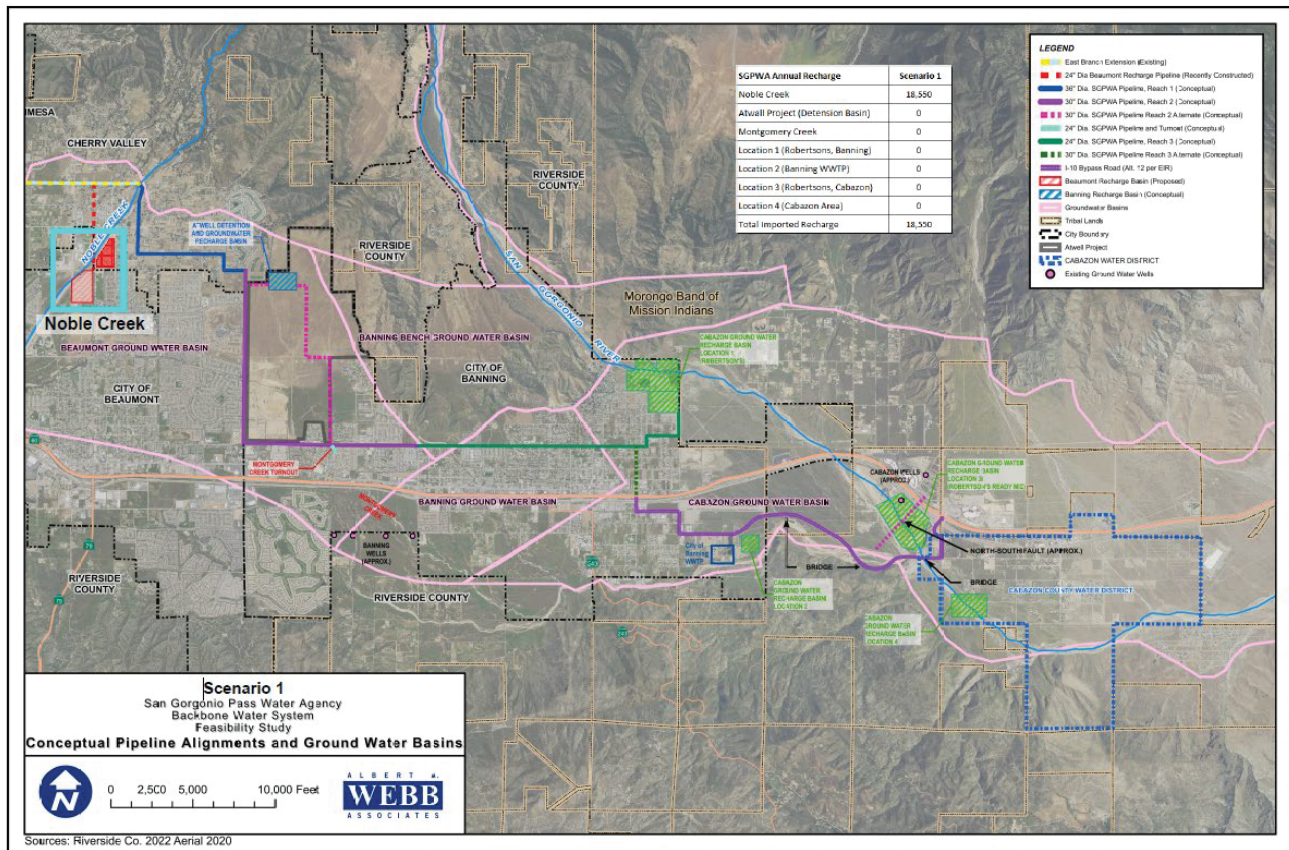

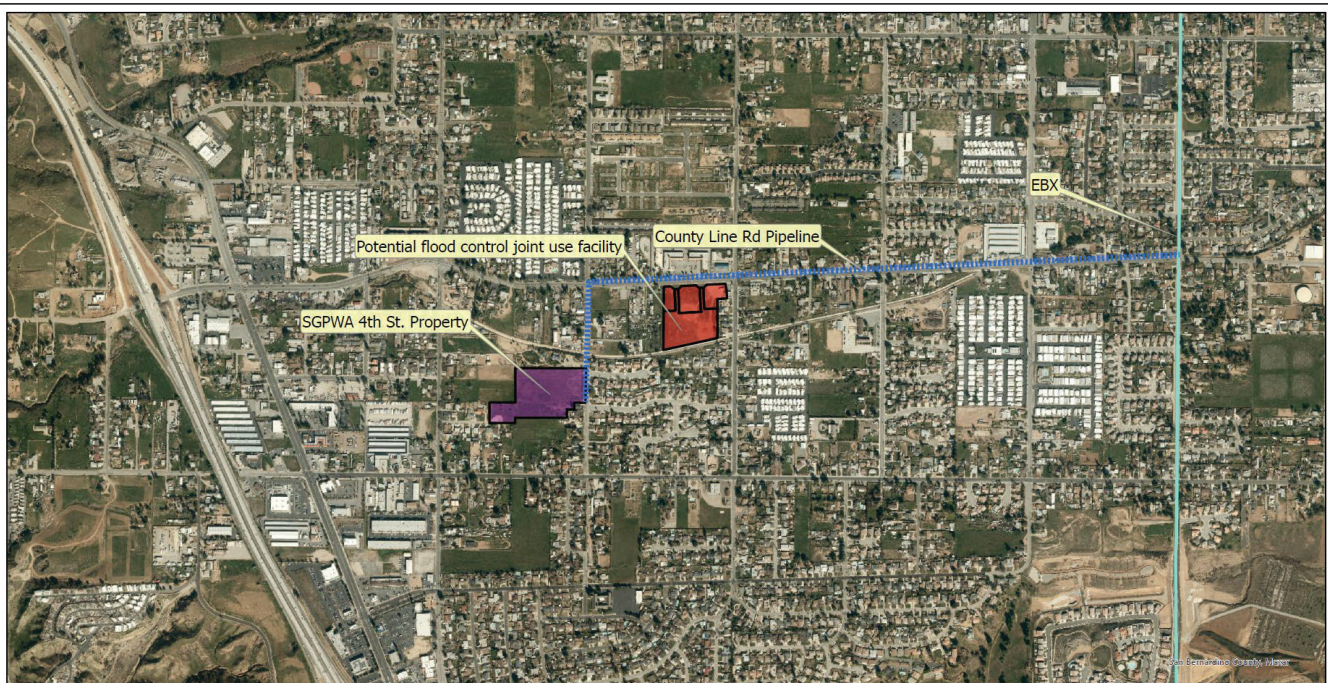
Historic SWP Allocations



2023 SWP Allocation & Portfolio Update

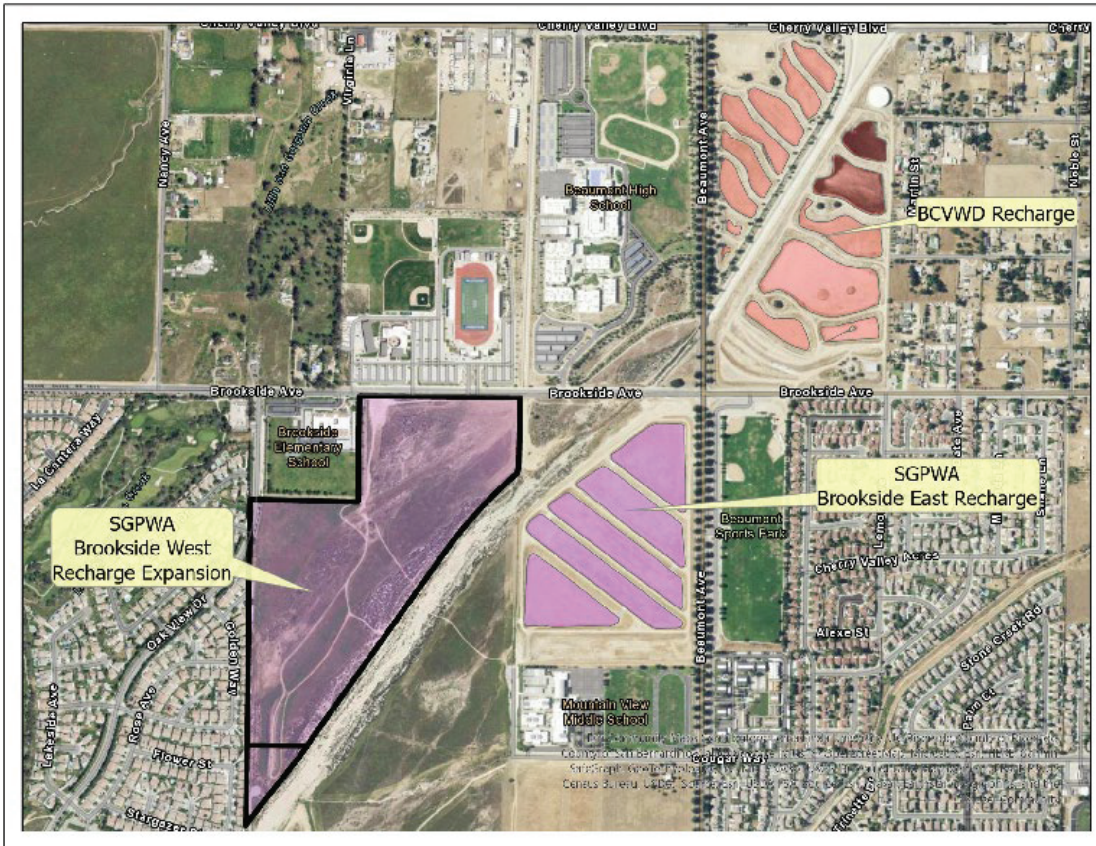


15-2025-22-0025-K05 PR0 SGPWA Backbone System Map created 07 Jun 2022
