I. CALL TO ORDER

A special meeting of the Banning City Council was called to order by Mayor Wallace on April 16, 2021 at 2:35 P.M.

II. WORKSHOP

Authorization of additional police officers for the Banning Police Department.

Matthew Hamner, Chief of Police, briefed the City Council on department needs. He requested that five additional police officer positions be authorized in the current fiscal year.

Jennifer Christensen, Administrative Services Manager, shared financial projections for budget increases already requested from the Police Department and not including the addition of any police officer positions. She said that the department was already facing a more than \$1 million deficit in the current fiscal year.

There was discussion regarding the total cost of hiring each additional officer, potential savings from eliminating overtime, as well as potential funding sources.

III. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Mayor Wallace opened the agenda item for public comment.

John Hagen said that the City cannot eliminate overtime in policing. He said that he was against defunding the police and stated the funds for these additional officers should come from other areas in the City's budget.

Laure Leindecker said she felt there was a homeless problem in the City but that she feels safe in the community.

Mayor Wallace closed Public comment.

City Council discussed potential intermediate options, such as authorizing two or three additional police officer positions.

Direct staff to prepare a proposal to fund additional police officer positions at the April 27th Regular Meeting of the City Council.
