Incident: Death Investigation

On Monday, June 10, 2019, at 0722 hours, Officers from the Banning Police Department were dispatched to a baby not breathing call at a residence located in the 100 block of North Murray Street in the City of Banning, County of Riverside. The reporting party called 9-1-1 and advised Banning Police Dispatch that a three month old baby at the location was not breathing.

An officer arrived on scene within one minute of the original call. Once officers arrived, they observed that the baby was unresponsive and not breathing. Officers began performing life saving measures. Officers immediately took the baby to Cal-Fire Station #89 which is located at 172 North Murray Street and directly across the street from the residence. Cal-Fire Paramedics began to perform additional life saving measures; however, the baby was pronounced deceased a short time later.

The Banning Police Department Detective Bureau was summonsed to the scene and took over the investigation. At this time, there is no foul play suspected in the incident; however, the investigation is ongoing.
